The Student iPad Agreement

New for 2017-18

- ► Student iPad Agreement, called the REPS
- Required part of deployment

School District Policies Apply

- Policy 524 Internet Acceptable Use Policy
- ► Policy 514 Bullying Prohibition
- ► Policy 506 Student Discipline

Potential Consequences

- Loss of take home privileges
- ► Loss of technology use at school
- ► Phone call/note home
- ► Other consequences may be determined by school administrators/district officials

R: Be Responsible

- ► Keep it in the case at all times
- ► Transport in a backpack
- Clean with a soft cloth
- ▶ No food or beverage near the iPad







E: Be Engaged

- Only appropriate pictures/videos
- Positive communications only
- ► Headphone use directed by teacher



P: Be Productive

- ► Fully charged battery everyday
- Apps from Self-Service only
- ► Enough storage space to do learning
- Proper citation of sources





S: Be <u>S</u>afe

- ▶ Don't leave it in a car
- ▶ Do not leave the iPad charging unattended
- ► Keep away from public view
- Students should keep passcode private

Prepared for iPad Deployment, Fall 2017

Important Items to Remember:

- ► The iPad is property of Osseo Area Schools
- ► The iPad is for instructional and school use only
- If your student un-enrolls or it is the end of the school year, you **must return** the iPad. You will be charged \$514 if it is not returned.



The iPad Protection Plan

Changes to the 2017-2108 Protection Plan

- Open Enrollment ends on October 27, 2017
- ► Accept/Decline coverage on FeePay
- ► Families who do not enroll by the end of Open Enrollment will decline coverage



How to complete FeePay

- 1. Two ways to complete FeePay:
 - a. Receive support at the end of this presentation (Computer Lab)
 - b. Use the instruction sheet and complete at home

Protection Plan Coverage

What is covered

- One incident of accidental damage, not including replacement of the device due to damage beyond repair, at no charge.
- ► <u>70%</u> of iPad cost is covered for the full-replacement of the device, if required due to damage beyond repair.
- ▶ <u>70%</u> of the cost for the replacement of the device, if required due to theft.
- ▶ <u>50%</u> of the cost for the replacement of the device, if required due to loss.

What is not covered

- Damage to the case, cable, or charger.
- Loss of the case, cable, or charger.
- Intentional or reckless damage.
- Damage that occurs when the iPad is out of the district-issued case.
- ► Tampering of the operating system.
- ▶ Damage beyond the second incident.
- Spare iPad



How Your Student Will Make a Claim

- ► Bring iPad to Media Center within <u>1 School Day</u> of incident occurring, even if student can still use it.
- ► The iPad Tech ESP will help you with the process.
- When the iPad comes back you have <u>30 days</u> to renew your iPad Protection Plan.

Where Your Child Should Go If They Need Help

- Visit your school's Tech ESP in the Media Center, if:
 - -The iPad is not working.
 - -The iPad is missing, they have the tools to help.
 - -The iPad has a broken screen.
- ► If you find an iPad, <u>return</u> it to the Media Center.
