Courtyard Doors

The courtyard isn't accessible because the doors don't function right. They need to be completely replaced and some electrical work done. Discussed misgivings about doors not being allowed to lock at any time. The estimate is \$15000-\$20000. Years ago Lowe's offered grant money to schools with 501c3 status, which Cedar Island has. Found out they don't do this anymore. One idea is to ask school parent volunteer to serve concessions at a Twins game to fund this. When the doors are fixed, teachers will have the freedom to bring classes outside. However, teachers with classroom windows on the courtyard side have mixed feelings about having students in the courtyard. It may be a distraction to class. In the past it's been used for 6th grade graduation, reading time for the students, and a few other activities. Some teachers have been sprucing up the space.
