

Morning Arrival

We expect our parking lot to be congested and ask parents to use our buses instead of driving children to school. If there is inclement weather, consider driving the child to the bus stop rather than school. This will greatly assist with the level of congestion.

Parent Drop Off: Students enter the building at **9:20**

1. Use the north lot only – entering at the stoplights.
2. Follow the path along the curb in a single file line pulling up as far as the cars ahead of you will allow. Please be sure children are completely prepared so they may *quickly* exit the right hand side of the vehicle along the curb.
3. Follow the cars in front of you and exit the parking lot. For safety reasons, please do not drive around cars.

Parent Parking:

Park in the north lot and walk with your child(ren) to the crosswalk. When the crossing guard lowers the flag, walk across the crosswalk and onto the sidewalk. Due to the age and size of our students, please do not send them across the parking lot alone. Give your child a hug and say goodbye 😊

OakView Students:

Oak View students who are dropped off in the Cedar Island parking lot should stay on the paths when walking to Oak View. They are not allowed to enter the building as we do not have supervision available.

Afternoon Dismissal - begins at 3:55 3:45 for Early Childhood students

Again we ask parents to use the buses rather than picking them up by car. Enter the north parking lot (at the stop light). For safety reasons, the sidewalk dip will be coned off. When a parent needs to pick up their child at dismissal time follow these procedures:

1. Parents must park in the north lot.
2. Enter the front foyer of the building and students will meet parents inside of the building. We do not allow children to walk to the cars without the assistance of their parents. Parent pick-up children will not be allowed to wait outside for safety reasons.

Students Who Walk Home

These students will be released at 4 PM and should follow the sidewalk if going to the south and the paths or sidewalk if going north. See the attached map.
