Operators will have a list of participating dental offices and will direct you to a dental office to call and schedule an appointment.

Notes from Nurse Mary

ASTHMA MANAGEMENT BASICS:

- **Learn Your Triggers—and avoid them.** Triggers include pollens, odors, and smoke.
- **Avoid Scents.** Do not wear or have your student wear perfume to school.
- **Control Your Environment.** Avoid the allergen. No pets especially in the bedroom. Use allergen free covers for pillows and mattress if allergic to dust mites.
- **Try Some Prevention.** Do not smoke during pregnancy. Breast feed if possible. Breast milk is unlikely to trigger an allergy and boosts the immune system.
- **Monitor Your Breath.** Do peak flows using the peak flow meter. If the rate is less than 50%, see a doctor.
- **Use Medicines.** Most people use a short term medication such as albuterol inhaler or nebulizer form.
- If you have not provided albuterol to the nurse for your student, please do so now. Any questions call the nurse at 763-549-2322.
