Coat distribution sites will be open from 10:00 a.m. until supplies run out on Thursday, October 27, 2016. All items will be distributed on a first-come, first served basis. **Call the Coats for Kids Hotline at 651-746-3412 to find out which location serves your area.** There is no pre-registration for the event, but you will need to go to the distribution site which serves your local area based on your address. Families must meet the following requirements: **1) dependent children must be ages 0-17, 2) need to produce a photo ID, 3) must have a current piece of mail confirming your ZIPCODE 4) must bring one form of ID for each child, copies accepted (medical card, social security card, birth certificate, school ID, passport, etc.**

Parents can shop for a coat and winter accessories for each child. The coat distribution is for adults to attend.
