KINDERGARTEN

- Large backpack (NO wheels)
- 2 bottles Elmer's white glue or similar (NO gel)
- 12 glue sticks
- 3 boxes (24 count only) of Crayola crayons or equivalent quality
- 1 medium size pencil box (plastic-5x8)
- 2 pocket folders, (NO prongs)
- 2 dozen #2 sharpened pencils
- 1 pair of school scissors
- 1 pair of headphones (NO ear buds)
- White T-shirt (2 sizes bigger than what child wears)

- 10 jumbo glue sticks (or 20 small)
- 3 boxes of 24 count only Crayola crayons or equivalent quality
- 1 box of colored pencils
- Watercolor paints
- 6 black EXPO dry erase markers or equivalent quality
- 2 highlighters
- 2 sets thick color washable markers
- Headphones without volume controls for computer use
- 1 container Clorox wipes or similar to share-*voluntary donation*

- 2 drawing pads (9" x 12")
- 1 New Elmer's glue or similar
- 3 New Elmer's glue sticks or similar
- 1 Fiskars metal pointed scissors (age 6-9) or equivalent quality
- 1 school box (No bigger than 5"x8")
- 1 watercolor set with brush (Prang or Crayola) or equivalent quality
- 2 erasers (pink or green is best)
- 2 boxes of crayons (24)
- 8 pack washable markers
- 3 white board markers – **black only**
- 48 #2 yellow pencils, sharpened
- Small pencil sharpener (with a cover)
- 1 box colored pencils – sharpened
- 1 pkg. square Post-its 3"x3"
- Bag of real coins for counting money in Math (8 quarters, 10 dimes, 10 nickels, 20 pennies)

- Flair Pens (Marker-tip) (blue, green, black)
- 1 box color crayons (24 or more)
- 1 box colored pencils (sharpened)
- 2 boxes colored markers (fine point & broad tip)
- 2 colored ink pens for correcting
- 1 pkg. of 4 white board markers
- 1 white board eraser or clean sock
- 1 scissors 6" or larger

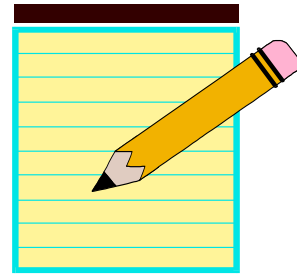

GRADE 5

NO 3-ring Notebooks such as Trapper Keepers or other large organizers.

- 1 Binder (2-inch) If possible, we highly recommend buying an extra binder due to wear and tear during the school year
- Dividing tabs to go inside of binder (at least 6 tabs)
- 2 folders (sturdy, plastic-coated, 3-hole punched)
- 2 Composition Notebook (NO spiral notebooks please)
- 1 **5-Subject** notebook (this will be the only spiral notebook your child should have)
- 1 pkg. plastic slip sheets/sheet covers
- 1 pkg. Post-its (3 inch size)
- 2-24 packs of #2 pencils
- 1 big eraser or eraser tops
- Pencil sharpener
- 1 pkg. blue pens, red pens OR black pens
- 1 pkg. of highlighters
- 1 Pencil pouch (3-hole punched that can fit inside of binder)
- 1 hard case supply holder (for additional supplies like crayons, scissors, etc.)
- 1 scissors (sharp, good quality)
- 1 pkg. Elmers glue sticks or equivalent quality
- 1 box colored pencils (24 count)
- 1 box of crayons
- Black Flair pens (marker tip, used for projects)
- 1 fine-tip black Sharpie
- 1 ruler (metric and inches)
- Lightweight headphones to use with i-Pad
- Water bottle to keep at school
- 4 boxes of Kleenex or similar to share- *voluntary donation*
- 1 container Clorox wipes or similar to share- *voluntary donation*
- A *voluntary* \$10.00 *donation* for classroom supplies and special activities
