1. Introductions start the meeting at 6:30
2. Principal update: 3 weeks until Winter conferences. January 28th is when the conference sign up will open up and first conference day is February 5th.
Few morning conference slots will be open for winter conferences. No school on February 4th. No more hard copy for report cards. They will all be available on parent view. Big push for all families to get onto parent view. Testing season is around the corner. We are a pilot school for map testing to be measured winter to winter. We were chosen to have a few extra tests for a select chunk of the students. Had bootcamp last week to refresh the students on school expectations. This will take place after spring break as well. We are the only school in the district to be an AVID school. Write, Inquiry, collaboration, organization, reading
We want to partner with the parents to collaborate with. January 29th will have a breakfast time and then learn about the AVID program from the program coordinator and then time in the student's classroom to see these skills in use in the classrooms. 7. Book Fair: Dinosaur theme Set up on Monday February 4th. Book fair starts with conferences on February 5th. 3,960 in scholastic money. Fundwalk will get 3,000. Book walk is February 26th.
8. Treasurer update: no climb theatre bill yet. Overall our accounts are pretty good but a lot of budgeted items have not hit yet. Savings 20,703 and

checking 17,411 as of this morning. Still waiting on boxtop and carnival incomes. *still working on deciding what equipment will go out on the playground*

9. Playground equipment: approx. 10,500 budget for equipment. Any extra will come from teacher request next year budget. Voted in by the board.
