*Introductions started the meeting at 6:30 PM

*Principal Update: admin team-Alia, Steve, Ben, Cortlandt, Kelsey

800 students enrolled, closed to open enrollment, playground may need some attention this year, the M has been removed and we need to discuss further about replacing it with a new structure. Possibly thinking about removing the pea rock. We will check with Mr. Krueger for ideas. We are fully staffed finally. BBQ will be on the north side of the building again like last year for the Fund Walk event. Edinbrook is a voting site and it is a no school day/professional development day for teachers. You can still be part of the DPAC. Email Mr. Krueger if interested.

*open board positions: Vice president is open at this time. Responsible for ice cream social, help president and help with those duties, main contact if not an event coordinator and chairperson for movie nights. Could be a Co- Vice president if interested. (A lot more assisting so could be a helpful first spot)

*Fund Walk: This is our main fundraiser. Kiddos get to raise money and they get different prizes for each level that is raised. Then on the fund walk day they get to go walk around the school to celebrate. Once your student is registered they get a lanyard and then they get different prizes for each money level. Prizes are delivered each day to keep the excitement going! Lanyards and monster keychains are ordered. We use a website called movin crew to register and donate. Online donations charge a fee but cash will go straight to school. Kickoff is on September 13th during school hours (2 and 2:35) Fundraising will happen over the next two weeks. Fund walk is on September 28th. School prizes like donuts and pizza on the roof happen shortly after the end of the fundraiser. (first few weeks in October) All call will go out on the 27th to families.

*Book Fair: Held twice a year during conference time. All staff will get a \$5 credit for books from scholastic. Wish list for teachers will still happen. We will still collect change to "fill the boot" to donate to the library. We are setting up at the end of the September (27th or 28th). Parent volunteers will help during the book fair if interested.

*Box tops: Starts October 15th and ends the 26th. Leaves theme for competition. We could use help on the 26th of October for counting the box tops. Can send them into school in bags of 50. Please check expiration on Box tops. We also

collect Milk moola from Kwik Trip, Loaves for Learning upc code (from Village Hearth) and Tyson codes.

*Bingo: Bingo happens in November on the 16th. This is our first community/school builder. Bingo cards and food cost money. We go to community places to get donations for the Bingo prizes. (restaurants, baskets from places, hotels...)

*Treasurer Update: We are on a budget year from 7/1-6/30. Checking was at \$14,257.67 and savings was \$9,696.94. Last year big item was washer and dryer for the nurse's office. Discussed removing wordmasters from expenses. And discussed the line items from expenses that we did not use. Teacher requests are October, January and March. They are sent to Mr. Krueger first and approves them and then they come to the October meeting to present to the PTO. (Have to be present at the PTO meeting!!)

Checking at the beginning of the school is \$14,393 and savings is at \$9,698. Changing box top fund raising to \$1,400 instead of \$2,000.
