

Free federally funded meals provided to children at four Osseo Area Schools locations this summer



Children ages 18 and under are eligible for free meals at four Osseo Area Schools locations this summer. The meals are funded through the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA). Due to federal requirements, meals can be served only during the exact times and dates specified below.

Lunch: 11:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m.

Meals will be provided to all children at no charge without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability, and all meals will meet nutritional standards established by the USDA. Adults may purchase a meal for \$4.
