

Our Elm Creek staff community utilizes S.O.A.R. tickets to recognize positive student behavior. All staff have S.O.A.R. tickets that are printed on orange cardstock paper (see example below). Our staff will be passing out these tickets to students that demonstrate Striving to their best, Owning their actions, Acting respectfully and are Ready to learn. The S.O.A.R. tickets can come from any staff member in the building.

Students that receive a SOAR ticket will bring home part of the ticket that recognizes the positive behavior that they have demonstrated. The other piece will go into a grade level bucket for a weekly drawing that will be recognized on the ECTV along with a certificate for their achievement.

Another component of PBIS is to celebrate our achievements school wide. This happens monthly when all classrooms have meet a targeted ticket goal. Some examples of school wide celebrations are the following: Dance Party, Flashlight Reading, Extra Recess and Game Day.
