## PRIORITY ENROLLMENT

Priority enrollment for Summer 2018 begins 1/9/18 and is guaranteed through 2/6/18. We will continue to take enrollments until we are at capacity, at which point we will start a waitlist. Field trip dates are not guaranteed after priority enrollment ends due to possible field trip limits reached.



## CONTRACTS

Additionally, the SPOT offers specialized camps, academic support and activities to promote personal growth and student success. Participating in the SPOT provides students with the opportunity for program ownership, encouragement from caring adults, life skill development, and fun.

## REGISTRATION

Registration completed within the priority deadline (2/6/18) requires a non-refundable registration fee of \$25 per student contract. Registration completed after the deadline increases to \$35 per student contract. Field trip events and dates may change prior to 5/16/18.

Unlimited free contract changes are allowed from 1/9/18 to 5/16/18 at 11:59pm if days are available. After 5/16/18 you will be locked into your contract for the summer, and subject to the commitment day policy in your terms and conditions. Days may not be available due to staffing ratios or field trip ticket pre-orders.

After the commitment deadline:

- Days may be added on space-availability
- Families may drop days if notice is received by 11:59pm Wednesday prior to the affected week and will incur a drop fee of \$15 per child. Request must be made via Email to [CECares@District279.org](mailto:CECares@District279.org)
- No swapping or banking of days are allowed
