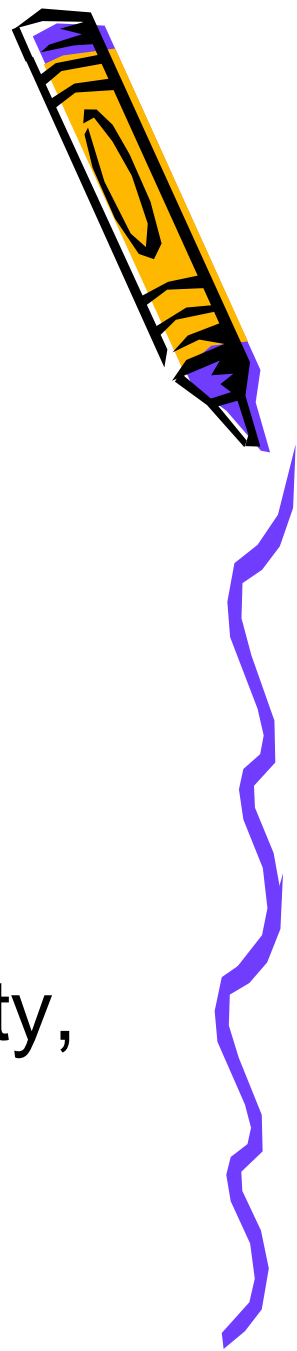

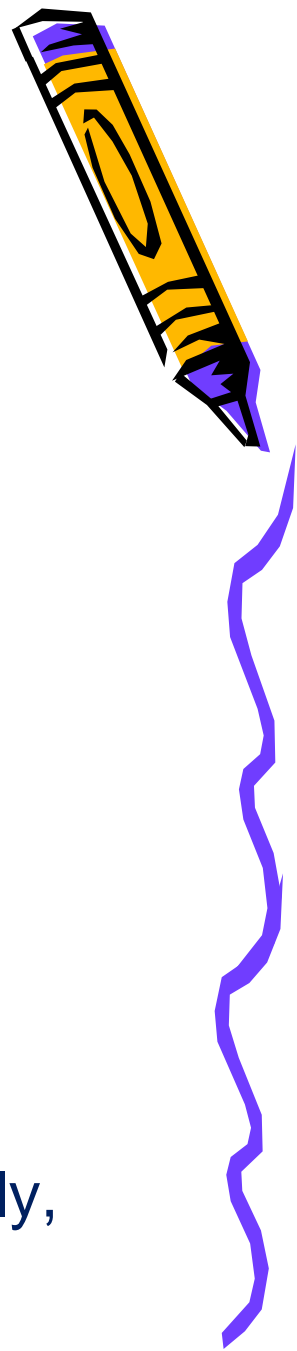
Our Goals

Classroom Community



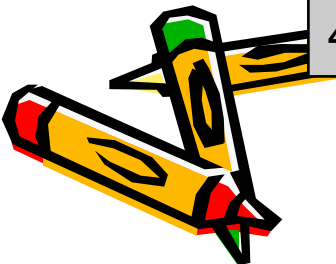
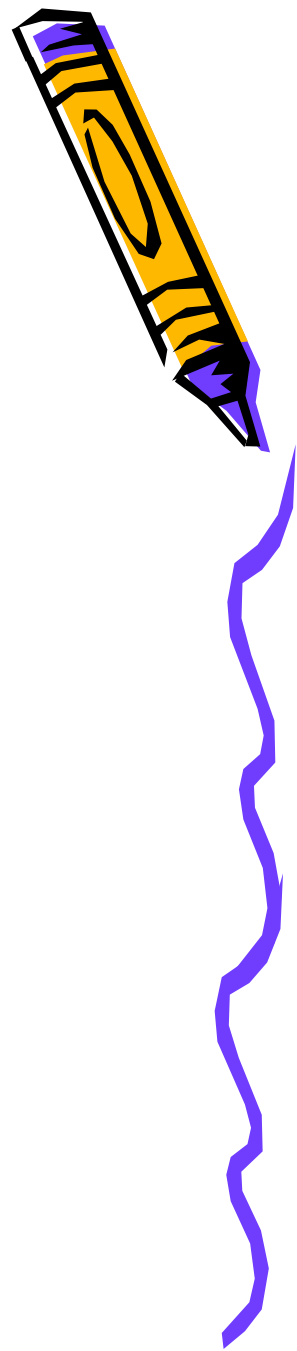
- Our classroom is a community. In our community, we have rules to help us get along with each other.

 - Work as a team.



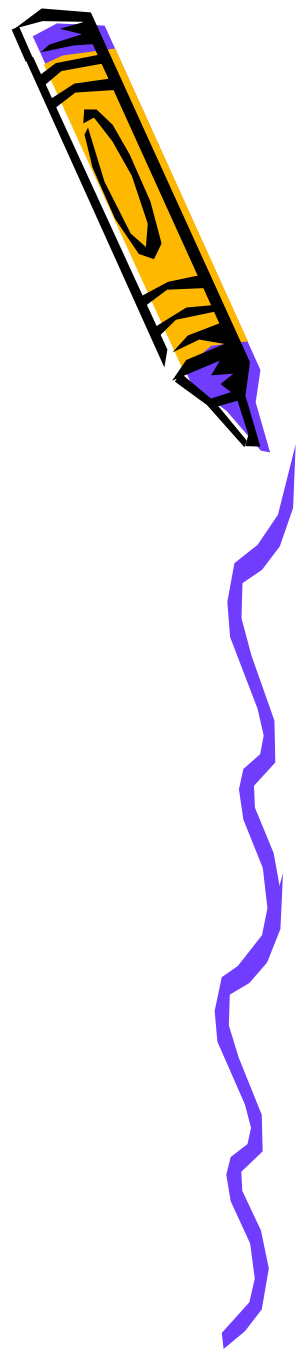

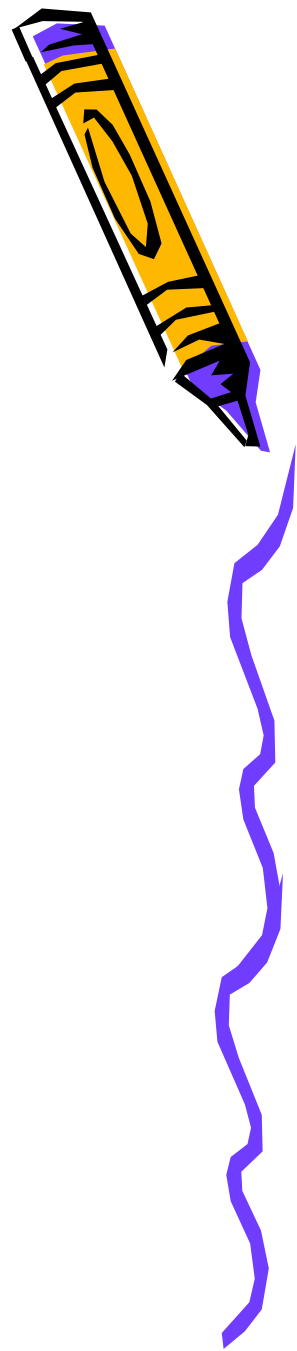
Class Subjects

Reading and Writing

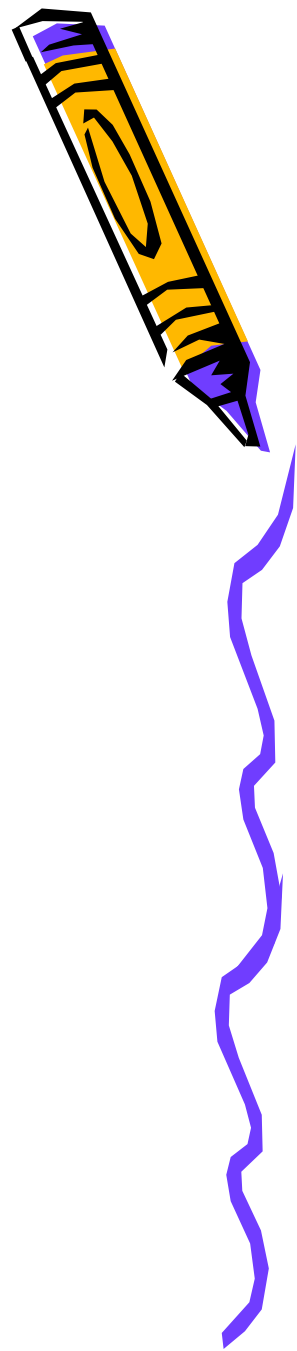


- Benchmark literacy

 - 15 minute rotations

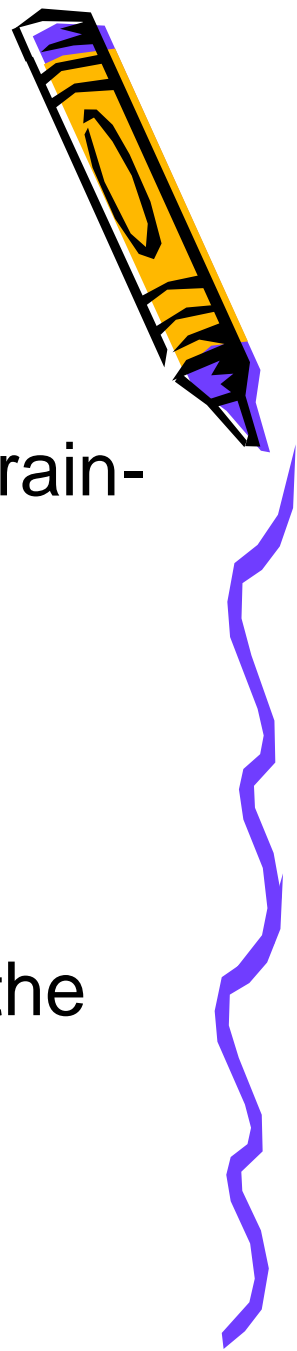


Assessments

 - MCAP



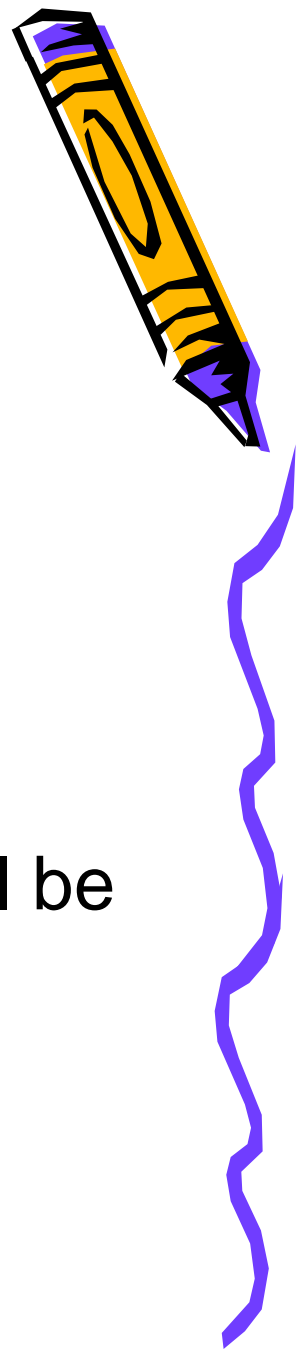
Homework

- Occasionally we will have homework on the iPad



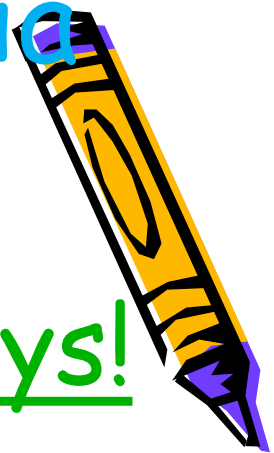
Band and Orchestra
