Dress Code: As part of our School-Wide PBIS we have **School-Wide Dress Expectations** for all students.

The **School – Wide Dress Expectations** are as followed:

- * *All Student's shorts and or dresses should come close to the knees as possible (No SHORT SHORTS).*
- * *Students should not wear tank tops (Male and Female Students) or spaghetti straps.*
- * *Students should not show their stomachs or mid-section area.*
- * *Students should not have their pants or shorts sagging below their waist at any time.*
- * *Students should not wear clothing with excessive rips or tears in them.*
- * *Students should not show their undergarments at any time.*
- * *Students should not wear sunglasses at any time.*
- * *Students should not wear any type of hat, scarf or bandana at any time, unless it is for religious purposes.*
- * *Students should keep all jackets, coats, and outer-wear garments in their lockers.*
- * *Students should keep all bags, backpacks and medium to oversized purses in their lockers.*
- * *All students clothing should free of any gang symbols and references as well as illegal substances, obscene images and profane language.*

Students who are not following the Dress Expectations will be sent to the Administration office to change into appropriate school attire or to call a parent to bring them an appropriate attire to change into.

Note: Students may also be held out of class until they are able to change into an appropriate outfit.
