Dunwoody College of Technology offers two great scholarship programs for new students. The **Women In Technical Careers Program** is designed to help female students succeed in a technical degree program. Scholarships are awarded up to \$10,000 per year for women enrolled in automotive, construction, computer technology, or robotics and manufacturing, and who demonstrate financial need. Advising, mentoring and a cohort experience are included. They also offer the **Youth Career Awareness Program** - a six week paid summer camp filled with career exploration, field trips, and college-readiness courses. A \$20,000 scholarship plus additional financial support are offered to students who complete the camp and attend Dunwoody in the fall. Come to the CCRC on Monday, February 12th at 10:00AM to hear more.
