OCTOBER IS COLLEGE KNOWLEDGE MONTH! The goal during this month is to provide every graduating high school senior with the preparation, opportunity, and support needed to apply to college. This month-long initiative is sponsored by the Minnesota Office of Higher Education with a goal of encouraging students to do more than just submit an application. Applying is only one-step of the college application process - the result of thoughtful exploration and planning. During the month of October the CCRC will be offering
