STUDENT PARKING RULES

1. Any vehicle which a student parks in Park Center's parking lot must display a valid permit. The permit must be attached to the backside of the rear-view mirror. If a valid permit is not properly attached and visible, your vehicle is subject to be stickered or towed.
2. Any vehicle on school property is subject to search by school district staff based on reasonable suspicion that the search will uncover evidence of a violation of law or school rules.
3. Student vehicles must be parked in spaces designated for students (**NORTH LOT ONLY**).
 - A. Not in areas reserved for staff.
 - B. Not occupying more than one space.
 - C. Not parked illegally (e.g. handicapped space, "No Parking" zones, etc.)
4. Students must drive in accordance with the *Minnesota Traffic Laws and Ordinances of the City of Brooklyn Park*.
 - A. Obey the posted speed limit.
 - B. Yield to pedestrians.
 - C. Loud music laws enforced.
 - D. Careless Driving and other Statutes will be enforced.
5. Deposit litter in appropriate trash containers.
6. Students must not use their cars to leave school unless they have been properly cleared.
7. If you lose your permit during the trimester you will have to pay 1/2 of the original price to replace it.
8. **Students will incur fines for parking in lot without purchasing a current trimester permit.**

We believe that compliance with these rules is in the best interest of all the Park Center students. If properly used, the lot will be an uncluttered and safe place for students to drive and park. However, neither Park Center High School nor District 279 can be held responsible if theft, vandalism or accidental damage occur.
