Registration Fees

- Grades 1-4 boys and girls, \$90.00 – kids play as part of the elementary league
- Grade 5 boys, \$110.00 - kids play as part of the elementary league
- Grades 5-8 girls & grades 6-8 boys, \$140.00 - kids play as part of the Jr High league

Registration is now open!

Practices will start towards the end of October, with games starting right before Thanksgiving. Season runs through the end of Feb 2018.

Financial assistance:

Will be available on a limited basis only at the start of the season. To apply, you must attend an in-person registration event on 9/26 or 10/1. A picture ID and most recent W2 form are required to qualify for financial aid. We do not give full scholarships in the program and the remainder of the fee must be paid at the time of registration.

Late registrations: Will be accepted for an additional \$20.00 fee, if there are openings on teams. Late fees kick in on 10/15.
